### *Covenant Youth Empowerment's Counseling Services:*



#### **Assessments:**

Before Counseling begins, we must complete an assessment. Which can be done in the home, community or at our Counseling Centers. The assessment looks at the child's strengths, supports, needs, problems and helps identify and diagnose behavioral, emotional, and substance abuse issues. The assessment is used to guide the services and treatment the child receives.

#### **Individual Counseling:**

Our licensed Therapist conduct individual counseling services. Children with behavioral, emotional, and/or substance abuse problems qualify.

#### **Group Counseling and Training:**

Offered to children who require services due to Substance Abuse, Sexually Offending Behavior, Anger Management, etc. These sessions vary in size and structure based upon the topic.

#### **Paraprofessional (CSI):**

Their services consist of rehabilitative, environmental support and resource coordination considered essential to assist a youth and family in gaining access to necessary services and in creating environments that promote resiliency and support the emotional and functional growth and development of the youth.

#### **Family Counseling and Training:**

Provided by qualified professionals for the guardian, the families of children, and adolescents with behavioral, emotional, and/or substance abuse problems. This service may be provided with or without the youth being present.

#### **Crisis Intervention:**

Designed to prevent home displacement and/or hospitalization.

#### **IFI:**

A service intended to improve family relationships by clinically stabilizing the living arrangement, promoting reunification or preventing the utilization of out of home therapeutic venues (psychiatric hospital, therapeutic foster care, etc.) for the identified youth.

#### **Psychiatrist/Psychologist:**

Assessment and monitoring of an individual's status in relation to treatment with medication.

#### **Nursing Care and Assessment:**

This service requires face-to-face contact with the youth, adult, family, caregiver to monitor, evaluate, assess and/or carry out a physician's orders regarding the psychological and/or physical problems and general wellness of the youth and adults.
